Owners of **vacant lots** are responsible for maintaining their own lot and are reminded that as per the City of Vernon Good Neighbour Bylaw #4980, Part V – “Property Maintenance” and the Provincial Weed Control Act, you are required to cut and remove all weeds including noxious weeds on adjacent City boulevards. The City may proceed with the removal and all associated costs will be billed to the property owner or collected through property taxes in accordance with the Community Charter. BVSL, Seacliff and APM are not responsible to pursue owners of vacant lots for noxious weed control. Please contact the city of Vernon Bylaw office directly to report noxious weeds on a vacant lot.
